**-NOTES-**

**Doubling Rule:** You should double the final consonant of a one syllable base word if:

- the word has one \_\_\_\_\_ vowel,
- ends in one \_\_\_\_\_,
- and the \_\_\_\_\_ begins with a \_\_\_\_\_.

**Silent “E” Rule:**

If the base word ends with a silent “e”:

- Keep the “e” if the suffix begins with a \_\_\_\_\_.
- Drop the “e” if the suffix begins with a \_\_\_\_\_.

**“Y” Rule**

- If the word ends with a consonant + y, change the \_\_\_\_\_ to an \_\_\_\_\_ and add the suffix, UNLESS the suffix begins with an \_\_\_\_\_
- If the word ends with a vowel + y, \_\_\_\_\_ change the y.
