



Trimester Book Report Options



Directions: You are required to complete 2 activities from the list below in Trimester One and 3 in Trimesters Two and Three. Each book report is worth 10 points. **Start reading and have some fun!!!** 😊

1. **Written Report:** choose fiction or non-fiction format worksheets (various options in classroom folder and on web page)
2. **Biography Mini-Report:** flip book or worksheet
3. **Book Jacket:** design the dust jacket for your book. Include title, author, cover illustration, give it a review/rating, and write a summary on the back (paper provided in classroom)
4. **Poster/book cover:** design a poster or new book cover depicting the climax (most exciting part) of the story. *Inspire others to read the book!* Include details that depict the characters, setting, and key events.
5. **Interview**
Choose one character and write an interview as if he or she was a real person. You come up with the questions AND the answers. Write at least ten questions that will give the character the opportunity to discuss his/her thoughts and feelings about his/her role in the story
6. **Diary**
You are a character in the book. Choose a pivotal moment in the plot and come up with what your journal entry would say.
7. **Comic Strip**
Retell the story in the form of a comic strip. Consider the most essential moments that you'll need to include in eight or ten frames.
8. **Diorama**
Construct a diorama (three-dimensional scene which includes models of people, buildings, plants, and animals) of one of the main events of the book. Include a written description of the scene.
9. **Timeline**
After reading a book of history or historical fiction, make an illustrated timeline showing events of the story and draw a map showing the location(s) where the story took place.
10. **OPTION:** Propose a different creative idea to your teacher!
