## SILENT E RULE

If your word end in a silent e:

- 1) Drop the silent e if the suffix begins with a vowel (-ing, -er, -es, -est, -ed, -y)
- 2) Keep the silent e if the suffix begins with a consonant (-ly, -ful, -less, -ment, -ness)

## Examples:

$$hope + ing = hoping$$

$$hope + ed = hoped$$

$$hope + ful = hopeful$$

$$hope + less = hopeless$$

$$spice + ed = spiced$$

$$spice + y = spicy$$

(Double strike through e indicates dropping)
