

SILENT E RULE

If your word end in a silent e:

- 1) Drop the silent e if the suffix begins with a vowel
(-ing, -er, -es, -est, -ed, -y)
- 2) Keep the silent e if the suffix begins with a consonant
(-ly, -ful, -less, -ment, -ness)

Examples:

hope e + ing	= hoping
hope e + ed	= hoped
hope + ful	= hopeful
hope + less	= hopeless

spice e + ed	= spiced
spice e + y	= spicy

(Double strike through e indicates dropping)
